DHS CISA Region 7 Critical Manufacturing (CM) Sector Security Roundtable



The Chapter has been invited to participate in the DHS CISA Region 7 Critical Manufacturing (CM) Sector Security Roundtable webinar on Tuesday, December 5, 2023 (10:00 am-12:00 pm - CST). The two-hour event is an opportunity to share information that enhances cybersecurity and physical security and resilience, and to network with other sector partners from Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska.

Topics addressed include risks related to cybersecurity, natural hazards, the effects of local disasters, and physical security regarding the supply chain. The target audience for this roundtable is those businesses engaged in critical manufacturing which CISA defines as:

Machinery Manufacturing: Engine and turbines, power transmission equipment; earth moving, mining, agriculture, and construction equipment.

Transportation Equipment Manufacturing: Vehicles and commercial ships, aerospace products and parts, railroad and transit equipment.

Electric Equipment and Component Manufacturing: Electric motors, transformers, generators.

Primary Metals Manufacturing: Iron and steel mills and ferroalloy, aluminum production and processing, nonferrous metal production and processing.

Affected by CM sector: Those within the CM community that may be part of the supply chain, or somehow affected by the CM Sector.
