We're excited to spotlight Harold Rudd, STS, Safety Coordinator at Weber Inc., whose expertise and creativity are making a real impact—both on the ground and in the cloud.

At Weber, Harold has championed an innovative approach to safety training by developing branded microlearning content for the Weber Academy.

His goal: to provide short, targeted modules linked to specific tasks. When a technician is dispatched, they receive a quick, machine-specific refresher—covering topics like quick tips, lessons learned, lockout/tagout (LOTO), and safety procedures—delivered just in time.

"It's about delivering the right safety training at the right time—so it sticks and supports real-world work," Harold explains.

This just-in-time learning model has already contributed to a measurable reduction in injuries, while making safety training more relevant, actionable, and accessible for those who need it most.

Beyond Weber, Harold is a member of ASSP and has recently been given the opportunity to serves as the Newsletter Coordinator for the Heart of America Chapter. He's focused on creating a chapter newsletter that is engaging, informative, and a resource other chapters can look to as a model.

"I want our newsletter to reflect the same quality and purpose as the safety content I build—something people actually use and value," he says.
